

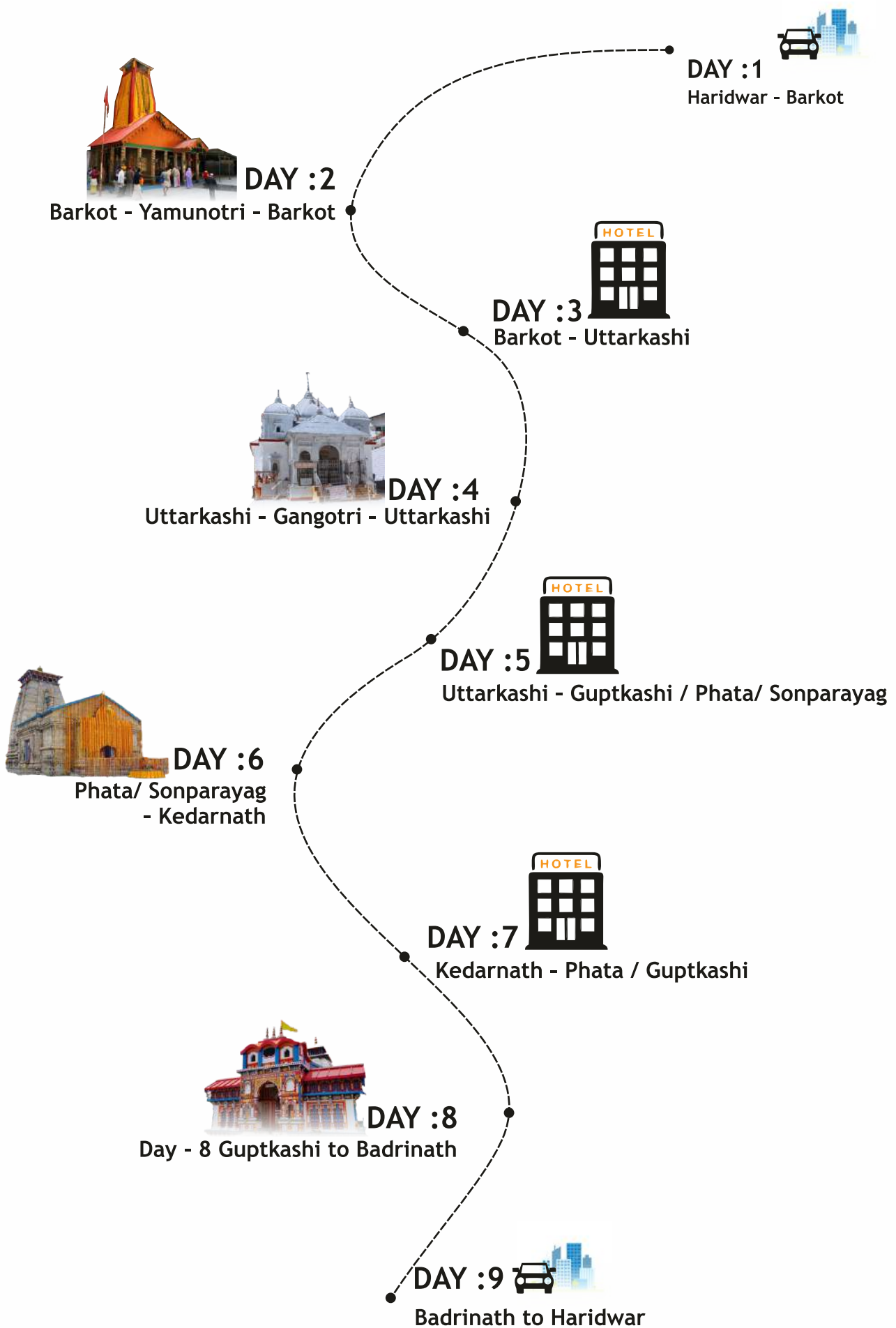

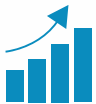

# Detailed Itinerary

## Day 1: Haridwar - Barkot

- **Route:** Haridwar - Dehradun - Mussoorie - Kempty Falls - Barkot
- **Drive Distance:** 190 km / 7-8 hrs
- **Altitude:** Haridwar (314 m) - Barkot (1,220 m)
- **Stay at:** Barkot/ Kharadi - Hotel Chauhan River View
- **Highlights:**
  - The journey passes through Mussoorie, a charming hill station known for its scenic beauty and colonial charm. If time allows, a short stop at Kempty Falls near Mussoorie refreshes travelers before continuing the drive. The landscape changes dramatically as the route enters the Yamuna Valley – terraced fields, apple orchards, and pine forests line the way, offering mesmerizing Himalayan views.





## Day 2: Barkot - Yamunotri - Barkot

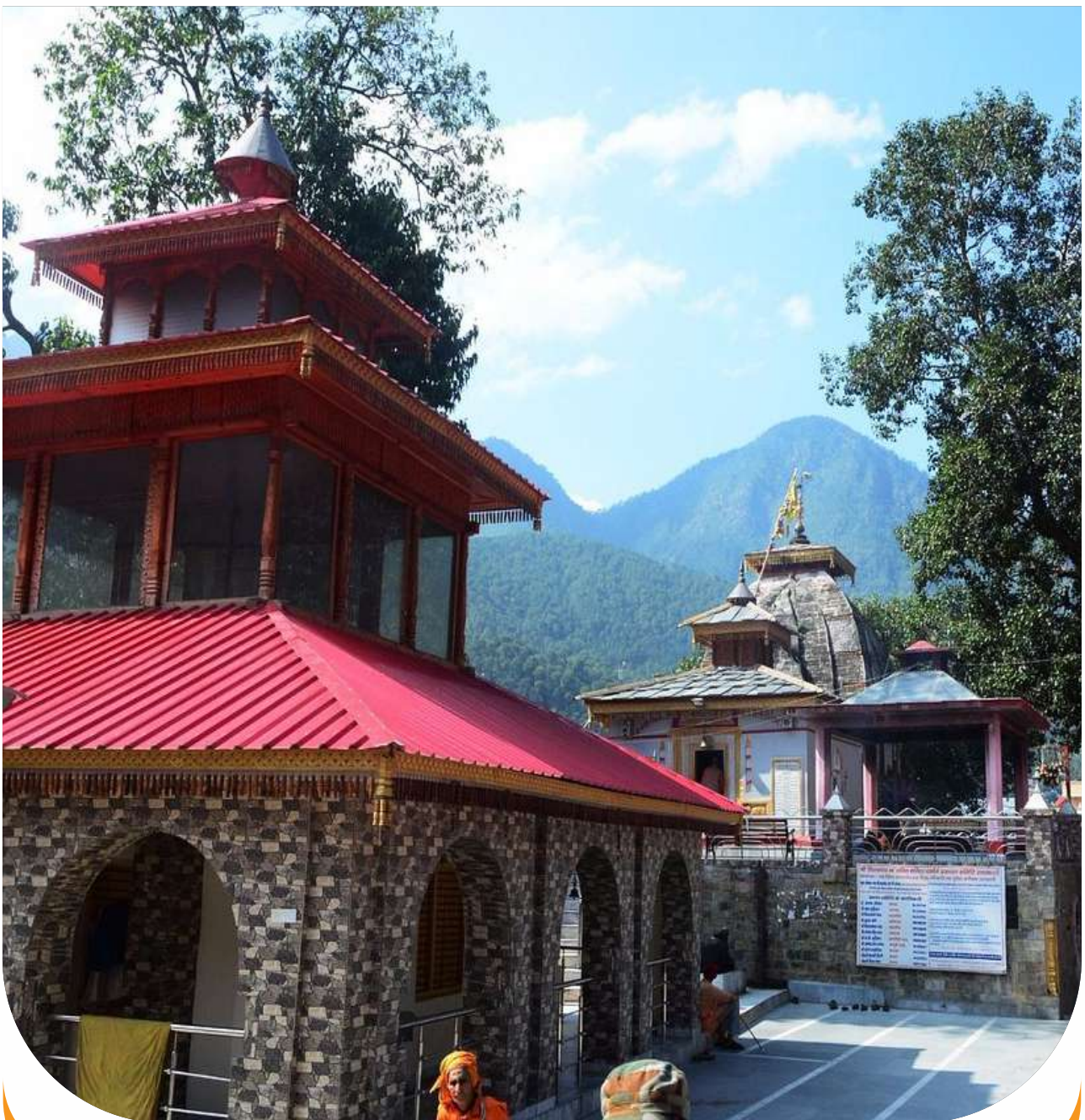
- **Route:** Barkot - Hanuman Chatti - Janki Chatti - Yamunotri (trek)
- **Distance:** 36 km drive to Janki Chatti + 5 km trek one way (10 km total trek)
- **Altitude:** Yamunotri (3,293 m)
- **Stay at:** Barkot - Hotel Chauhan River View
- **Highlights:**
  - Scenic drive via Shivalik hills, Yamuna valley.
  - **Yamunotri Temple:** Dedicated to Goddess Yamuna, symbolizing life, purity, and energy.
  - **Hot Springs - Surya Kund & Gauri Kund:** Devotees cook rice and potatoes in muslin cloth by dipping them into the hot water, considered prasad of the goddess.
  - **Divya Shila:** A sacred rock near the temple where pilgrims offer prayers before entering the shrine.





## Day 3: Barkot - Uttarkashi

- **Route:** Barkot - Dharasu - Uttarkashi
- **Distance:** 100 km / 5 hrs
- **Altitude:** Uttarkashi (1,158 m)
- **Stay at:** Uttarkashi- Ankit Palace/ Gangotri Eco
- **Highlights:**
  - Today pilgrims often visit the Vishwanath Temple, one of the most ancient and revered temples in the region. Dedicated to Lord Shiva, this temple is believed to be as holy as the Kashi Vishwanath Temple in Varanasi. The temple complex also includes a shrine for Goddess Parvati and a massive iron trident believed to have been used by Lord Shiva.





## Day 4: Uttarkashi - Gangotri - Uttarkashi

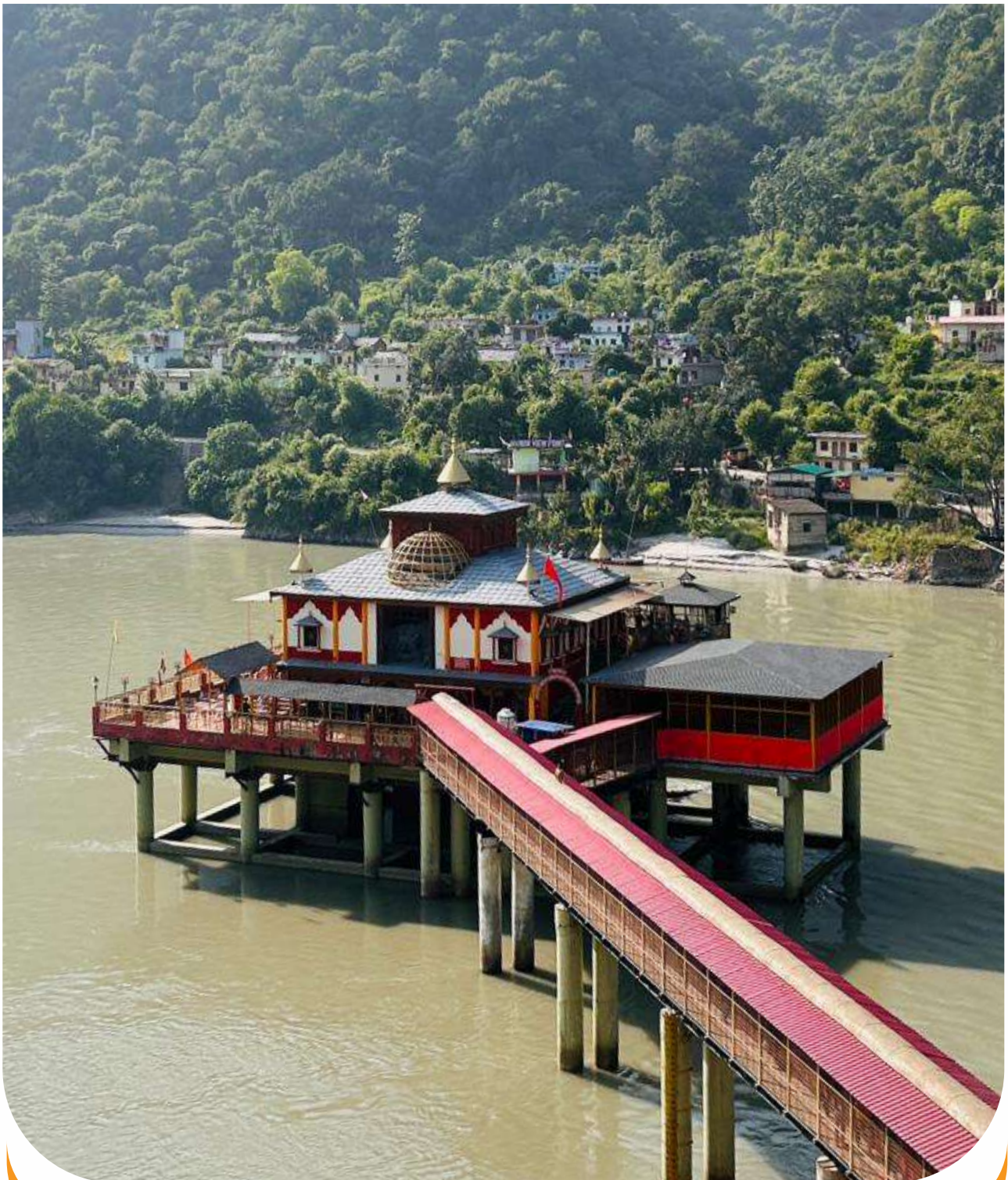
- **Route:** Uttarkashi - Harsil - Gangotri - return
- **Distance:** 100 km one way / 4-5 hrs (200 km round trip)
- **Altitude:** Gangotri (3,415 m)
- **Stay at:** Uttarkashi - Gangotri Eco
  
- **Highlights:**
  - **Gangotri Temple:** A white granite structure dedicated to Goddess Ganga, reflecting serenity and divinity.
  - **Gaumukh Glacier (12,795 ft):** The actual source of the River Ganga, 19 km trek from Gangotri, attracts trekkers and devotees.
  - **Bhagirathi Shila:** The rock where King Bhagirath meditated to bring Ganga to earth.
  - **Pandava Gufa:** Mythological cave where the Pandavas are believed to have meditated.
  - **Scenic Landscapes:** Surrounded by deodar forests, rugged mountains, and pristine river streams.





## Day 5: Uttarkashi - Guptkashi / Phata / Sonparayag

- **Route:** Uttarkashi - Tilwara - Agastyamuni - Guptkashi
- **Distance:** 220 km / 9 hrs
- **Altitude:** Guptkashi (1,319 m) / Phata (1,400 m)
- **Stay at:** Phata - Phata Resort / Hotel Krishna
  
- **Highlights:**
  - Mandakini river valley, Kedarnath views.





## Day 6: Phata/ Sonparayag - Kedarnath

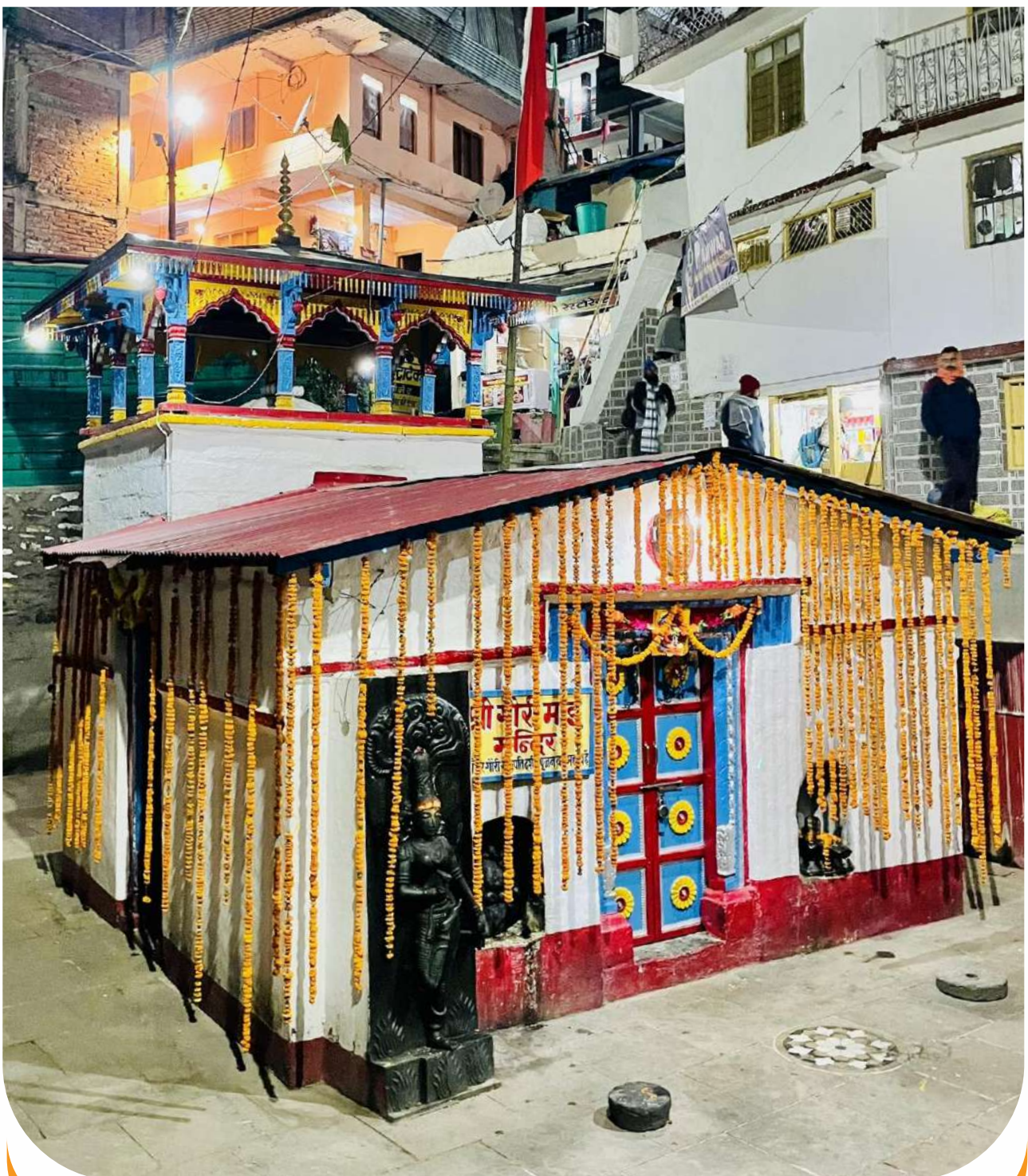
- **Route:** Drive to Gaurikund (7 km), then trek/pony/palki/helicopter to Kedarnath.
- **Distance:** 18-20 km by trek / helicopter from Gaurikund
- **Altitude:** Phata (1,520 m) - Gaurikund (1,982 m) - Kedarnath (3,583 m)
- **Stay at:** Kedarnath - GMVN , Agrawal Bhawan
- **Highlights:**
  - Shri Kedarnath Temple Darshan
  - Snow peaks of Kedarnath Range
  - Bhairavnath Temple
  - **Kedarnath Temple:** Built in ancient stone architecture, dedicated to Lord Shiva, the destroyer and protector.
  - **Mythological Importance:** Associated with the Pandavas and Adi Shankaracharya, who is believed to have attained Samadhi here.





## Day 7: Kedarnath - Phata / Guptkashi

- **Distance:** 18 km trek/heli + 7 km drive
- **Altitude:** Descend from Kedarnath (3,583 m) - Gaurikund (1,982 m) - Phata (1,520 m)
- **Stay at:** Phata - Phata Resort / Hotel Krishna
- **Highlights:**
  - Morning Darshan at Kedarnath
  - Return trek/heli to Gaurikund and drive back to Phata



## 📍 Day 8: Guptkashi to Badrinath

- **Distance:** Phata / Guptkashi - Badrinath (Approx. 220 km | 8-10 hrs)
- **Altitude:**
- **Badrinath - 3,133 m**
- **Stay at:** Badrinath - Hotel (as per package)
- **Highlights:**
  - Early morning departure towards Badrinath via scenic mountain roads
  - Witness changing landscapes from dense forests to high Himalayan terrain
  - Visit Narsingh Temple at Joshimath (winter seat of Lord Badrinath)
  - Arrival at Badrinath Dham and check-in
  - Evening Darshan at Badrinath Temple
  - Take a holy dip in Tapt Kund (natural hot water spring near temple)





## Day 9: Badrinath to Haridwar

- **Distance:** 300 km | 10-11 hrs
- **Altitude:** Haridwar - 314 m
- **Highlights:**
  - Early morning Badrinath Darshan (if not done previous evening)
  - Visit Mana Village - the last Indian village near Indo-Tibetan border
  - Explore: Vyas Gufa, Ganesh Gufa & Saraswati River origin point
  - Drive along the Alaknanda River valley towards Haridwar
  - **Sacred Confluences En Route:**  
The journey descends through the spiritually significant Panch Prayag, where rivers merge and form the sacred Ganga:
    - 1. Vishnuprayag: Confluence of Alaknanda and Dhauliganga
    - 2. Nandaprayag: Confluence of Alaknanda and Nandakini
    - 3. Karnaprayag: Confluence of Alaknanda and Pindar (linked to Karna - Mahabharata)
    - 4. Rudraprayag: Confluence of Alaknanda and Mandakini (associated with Lord Shiva)
    - 5. Devprayag: Final confluence where Alaknanda meets Bhagirathi to form the holy Ganga
  - Evening arrival at Rishikesh / Haridwar
